1	<p>The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (01 section each for Bal Vatika 1, 2 and 3 respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to X shall be restricted to 10. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq. ft. dimension. The number of students in each class shall be restricted to 40.</p>
2	<p>The lessor-leasee details given in the land certificate dated 26.05.2023 uploaded on SARAS are not in order. However, as per lease deed provided by the school vide e-mail (56107@cbseshiksha.in) dated 03.01.2024 society has owned the land by way of sale deed and leased the land to the school. Accordingly, revised land certificate is required to be obtained from the issuing authority. School shall obtain revised land certificate with correct details and submit compliance within 3 months.</p>
3	<p>Math lab looks like a temporary arrangement with few manipulatives displayed on tables. It appears to be more like a classroom rather than a lab and is without storage facilities. Composite science lab also does not have the seating arrangement for students. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the labs as per board's SOPs within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.</p>
4	<p>The ramp to access the upper floors has been overlaid on a staircase; hence it is very steep and unsafe, which is not acceptable. It is very difficult for wheelchair bound students/staff to navigate wheelchair/walker on ramp. Therefore, the school is directed to dismantle the same and re-construct the ramp or install lift to access upper floors, as per the provision laid in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines (https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf) within 03 months.</p>
5	<p>The school does not seem to have referred to RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board for CWSN toilets. The building is G+1, but only 1 CWSN toilet each for boys and girls are seen. It has been observed from the video link (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eR6mwnhL3dY) provided by the school that school has one separate CwSN toilet each for boys and girls. However, the school has claimed of having two CwSN toilets each for boys and girls (on different floors) by pasting different floor numbers at the entrance of toilets and showing on the video, which is not acceptable. The video link</p>

	clearly validates that these are actually one and the the same toilets. The school is hereby warned to stay away from such conduct. The School shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage, indicating the floor number, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
6	Inspection committee has reported that though the EPF facility is available for the staff of the school, however, EPF registration number has not been shown to the committee and advised the school to follow the mandatory provision in letter and spirit like EPF/ ESI subscription of all the employees. . School is required to make all statutory government compliance in this regard and submit the proof of compliance to the Board.
7	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Chennai within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/ Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.

5. The school is required to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
8. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
