The teachers should never go to the classes half-hand but prepare the day's lessons in such a way as to inculcate in to the young minds practical knowledge.


I do appreciate and congratulate the teachers who selflessly bring up the students. I do wish that all the teachers are of the same hue.

JANUARY 26 - REPUBLIC DAY.


The immeasurable joy and mental peace can be described **only** by those who had borne the heavy yoke of slavery.
